In rural Cambodia, the right to play is a powerful gateway to a better life. For the children of Siem Reap province, daily routines are often defined by demanding agricultural labor under a scorching sun or navigating the challenges of seasonal flooding. Physical education and recreational spaces are frequently viewed as luxuries rather than necessities.

Through the Globalteer Sports Programme, we are fundamentally changing this reality. This quarter, our mission to empower youth hit an extraordinary momentum, directly impacting the lives of over 2,000 children across our partner communities in the Doun Kaev commune. By combining world-class sports infrastructure with healthcare interventions, we are ensuring that poverty, gender, and geography are no longer barriers to a child's development.

Crucially, our program utilized this massive platform to champion gender empowerment. Our coaches ensured that both boys and girls competed on equal footing and were awarded trophies and medals across all athletic categories. By celebrating our female champions publicly in front of the entire district, we are helping dismantle deeply rooted rural stereotypes, proving to young women that they can play, compete, and lead freely in their society.

Milestone Events & Infrastructure

On January 23rd, our highly anticipated annual Temple Run reached its grand finish line in Siem Reap. What began as a dedicated training regimen throughout the winter months transformed into a massive, high-energy community celebration of perseverance and shared purpose. Hundreds of children, local teachers, international volunteers, and community members gathered early in the morning, creating an unforgettable atmosphere of excitement.

Standing on the starting line with their official running numbers pinned to their shirts, the children showcased incredible discipline and team pride. The impact of the Temple Run extended far beyond Cambodia's borders, a global network of international fundraisers took to the streets worldwide, running in solidarity. Dedicated global teams, including Education Explorers, Sport Stars, Healthy Runners, Teachers of the Future, Literacy Leaders, and Teachers Running for the Kids, successfully raised the vital resources that sustain our sports programming year-round.



Grand Inauguration of the New Sports Complex & Sports Day Festival



March 21st marked a historic milestone for our organization. The massive, 15,000 square meter community sports field complex, which was recently transformed from former mud-filled rice paddies, officially opened its doors. For the very first time, our students premiered fully completed, professional-grade installations, including a regulation-size football pitch, basketball courts, and structured running lanes.

To celebrate this achievement, we hosted our annual Sports Day Festival, welcoming roughly 1,200 enthusiastic attendees. Following a moving protocol ceremony with local educational authorities, the field erupted into healthy competition. Youth teams faced off across eight distinct athletic modules designed to test coordination, strategy, and sportsmanship, including tactical relay races, football tournaments, and high-energy tire-carrying endurance challenges, before gathering for a nutritious community snack.

Holistic Youth Wellness: The Randal Foundation Partnership



A child cannot thrive on the playing field if they are struggling with underlying health and nutritional deficits. We are honored to announce a vital new partnership with The Randal Foundation charity trust, which is transforming our sports initiative into a comprehensive wellness program.

- **Essential Medical Relief:** Financing deworming treatments and vital vitamin supplements for over 2,000 students across our partner schools.
- **Dedicated Clinical Tracking:** Hiring a professional medical nurse to perform routine health check-ups at the core school site and across rotating partner villages.
- **Community Capacity Building:** Delivering monthly workshops on nutrition, handwashing, first aid, and preventative care to parents, teachers, and local village leaders.

Challenges and Next Steps

As our program expands, managing safe transportation and logistics across remote villages remains a key focus. Thanks to our new Toyota Coaster minibus, children can now travel safely along rural roads to reach our sports classes and events. Moving forward, we aim to continue expanding our coaching capacity to maintain the highest quality of mentorship for every student enrolled in our network.
