The Teaching Development Volunteer will be responsible for designing new curriculum and bringing new ideas to the English program at Globalteer's after-school education programme for underprivileged children, aged 3-14, located in a small community outside the city of Cusco.

The successful candidate will be based in Cusco, Peru. The term of this position is from 3 to 6 months, with working hours negotiable between a part-time and full-time schedule. This is an unpaid position.
